Race One is Category 1, and Race Two is Category 2 in accordance with the current edition of Sail Training International Racing & 2 Sailing Rules & Special Regulations. 3 The Race organisers reserve the right to refuse acceptance of an entry.

- Composition of crew. For The Tall Ships Races Magellan-Elcano 2023 whilst no upper age limits are imposed, all race entries 4 are encouraged to recruit trainees between the ages of 15 and 25 years.
- No person under the age of 15 is to be on board during a race and associated events. For further details see current edition 5 of Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations, Part 3 Section A.
- 6 You **must** enter at least one race to qualify to take part in the Cruise-in-Company.
- 7 The minimum water line length for all vessels is 9.14m (30ft).
- 8 VHF radio, a Sat Coms transceiver, and a type approved 406MHz EPIRB are compulsory for these races.
- 9 Crew lists for each race must be submitted through the Gateway or via email using the template found on the Captains' Page.
- Late entries after 1 May 2023 may be accepted subject to the approval of the Race Committee and double Entry Fees as at 10 1 May 2023 will be charged.
- A penalty may be charged if all information required for rating purposes is not submitted by the closing date for entries, 1 May 2023. 11
- A proportion of the Entry Fee may be returned if, after it has been paid, or an Entry Form has been submitted, an owner or his 12 representative decides that his vessel cannot take part, provided the cancellation is due to an unforeseeable situation.
- 13 This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
- The Time Correction Factor (TCF), its associated applications, including 'Gateway', are the intellectual property of Sail Training International (STI) and its subsidiary companies and as such must not be used or reproduced for any purpose other than participating 14 in events organised by STI.

#### THE TALL SHIPS RACES MAGELLAN-ELCANO 2023 VESSEL PARTICIPATION

Vessels taking part in The Tall Ships Races are required to stay in the host ports for all 'official visit' day as listed on the first page of this Entry Form. The official days start at 12 noon on the first day of each port visit and include the parade of sail on the day of departure, as this is an important event for the ports and is an occasion when we can thank the local people for their hospitality and kindness.

Vessel operators and captains/masters are to make sure that any sailing plans or charters scheduled to commence after their vessel has left The Tall Ships Races should be designed so that their vessel can remain in port for the four designated official days and does not have to leave early. Vessels deciding to leave early will have no assistance in doing so from the organisers and must expect pay full commercial rates for tugs, pilots, etc.

## I/We agree that my/our vessel will arrive in each host port as outlined above on the first day and stay until the Parade of Sail on the last day.

#### RESPONSIBILITY AND DECLARATION

I/We UNDERSTAND that Tall Ships Races International Limited (TSRIL), host ports, sponsors and their agents and representatives are not responsible for the seaworthiness of, or in any incident to, my/our vessel entered and that all on board will take part in the care at their own risk and responsibility.

I/We UNDERSTAND that the Race Committee may not permit my/our vessel to take part in the race if they in their absolute discretion consider my/our vessel or its crew not fit to take part in a race for any reason whatsoever and that the Race Committee shall not be obliged to give any reason for their decision.

I/We CONFIRM that my/our vessel is legally licensed and insured to sail with trainees and take part in all programmed activities whether in port or at sea (including racing) as per rule 1.02.9 of the current edition of Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations.

I/We UNDERSTAND that Tall Ships Races International Limited (TSRIL) reserves the right to require a letter of authority from the owners of any vessel in respect of any Captain/Master or other person if such owner wishes to sign any declaration or other document on behalf of the vessel.

I/We AGREE that in any dispute or matter relating to the race, the decision of Tall Ships Races International Limited (TSRIL), or the Race Committee appointed by them, shall be final.
